

Jungla: Website Privacy Policy

Last Revised on July 3rd, 2019: This privacy policy (this “Privacy Policy”) explains how Jungla Inc. (“Jungla”, “we” or “us”) collects, uses and discloses information related to the Jungla website currently located at <https://jungla.bio> (the “Website,” and together with any successor URLs, applications and other online services Jungla may offer, the “Service”). By accessing or using our Service, you confirm that you have read, understood and agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy, do not access or use the Service

ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

The Services can only be accessed and used subject to this Privacy Policy. PLEASE READ THIS PRIVACY POLICY CAREFULLY. BY USING THE SERVICE, YOU ACCEPT ALL OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE JUNGLA PRIVACY POLICY AND REPRESENT TO US THAT YOU ARE 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AND ARE LEGALLY COMPETENT TO USE THE SERVICES. IF YOU DO NOT ACCEPT THE PRIVACY POLICY, THEN YOU ARE NOT AUTHORIZED TO ACCESS OR USE ANY OF THE SERVICES.

MODIFICATIONS OF PRIVACY POLICY

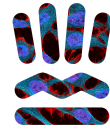
We may modify or update the Privacy Policy from time to time. It is your sole responsibility to check the Service from time to time to view any such changes in the Privacy Policy. When we change the Privacy Policy in a material manner, we will notify you by posting an announcement on our Website. Your continued use of the Service after any change constitutes your acceptance of the new Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to any of these terms or any future Privacy Policy, you may not use or access (or continue to access) the Service.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We only collect information about you if you submit information by using our “Contact Us” page. We may collect the following information from such submissions:

PERSONAL INFORMATION

“Personal Information” refers to information that specifically identifies who you are, such as your name, email address, and information relating to your health or your query. Your submission of Personal Information via the “Contact Us” page on the Website constitutes your consent to the use and disclose of your Personal Information as described below.



AGGREGATE INFORMATION

We may collect general, non-personal, statistical information about the use of the Services, such as how many users visit a specific page on the Website, how long they stay on that page, and which hyperlinks, if any, they click on. This information represents a generic overview of our users, including their collective viewing habits, and allows us and other third parties to modify information based on user traffic and behavior. We collect this information through the use of technologies such as 'cookies' and web beacons. We collect this information in order to help enhance the Services to make for a better user experience.

COOKIES

Jungla may automatically collect non-personally identifiable information and data through the use of cookies. Cookies are small text files a website uses to recognize repeat users, facilitate the user's ongoing access to the Website and facilitate the use of the Services. Cookies also allow a website to track usage behavior and compile site usage information that will allow for the improvement of content and target advertising. Most browsers allow you to control cookies, including whether or not to accept them and how to remove them. You may set your browsers to notify you if you receive a cookie, or you may choose to block cookies with your browser. However, please be aware that some features of our Services may not function or may be slower if you refuse cookies. You may also get cookies from other third parties with links on the Services as described below. We do not directly control these cookies.

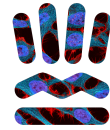
OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES

Tracking technologies may record information such as Internet domain and host names; protocol (IP) addresses; browser software and operating system types; clickstream patterns; the MAC address or other technical information from your mobile device; location information through GPS, WiFi, Bluetooth, or similar technologies; and dates and times that our Services are accessed. An IP address is a number that is automatically assigned to your computer whenever you are surfing the web. Web servers, the computers that 'serve up' webpages, automatically identify your computer by its IP address. The Services may also use technology called "tracer tags". These may also be referred to as "Pixels", "Clear GIFs" or "Web Beacons". This technology allows us to understand which pages you visit on the Website. These tracer tags are used to help us to optimize and tailor our Services for you and other users of our Services.

DO NOT TRACK

Do Not Track (DNT) is a privacy preference that users can set in some web browsers, allowing users to opt out of tracking by websites and online services. Jungla and the Services do not recognize DNT.

USE OF INFORMATION



The information we collect is used in the following ways:

- (a) to respond to your message;
- (b) to provide and support the Services;
- (c) to improve the Services;
- (d) for internal business analysis or other business purposes consistent with our mission; and
- (e) to carry out other purposes that are disclosed to you via the Services.

DISCLOSURES AND TRANSFERS OF INFORMATION

We may disclose your Personal Information to third parties as follows:

- (a) We have your permission to make the disclosure;
- (b) We may also disclose Personal Information if the disclosure is to a third party in connection with the sale, transfer or re-organization of some or all of Jungla or its assets applicable to the Services, and any such acquirer or transferee will have the right to use and disclose such information subject to the terms of this Privacy Policy;

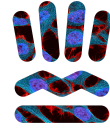
Prior to sharing of your Personal Information with others, agreements are made between Jungla and such outside parties to whom we are transferring data to provide for the allowable use and security of the transferred information in accordance with this Privacy Policy and applicable law. If Jungla becomes aware that any such outside party is improperly using or disclosing Personal Information, it will notify that outside party and request that it take reasonable steps to cease such use or disclosure.

We do not seek or knowingly collect any Personal Information about children under 13 years of age. If we become aware that we have unknowingly collected Personal Information from a child under the age of 13, we will make commercially reasonable efforts to delete such information from our database.

DATA SECURITY, INTEGRITY AND RETENTION

Please note that information you send to us electronically may not be secure when it is transmitted to us. We recommend that you do not use unsecure channels to communicate sensitive or confidential information to us. From time to time, we review our security procedures to consider appropriate new technology and methods. Please be aware though that, despite our best efforts, no security measures are perfect or impenetrable. We will retain your Personal Information for the length of time needed to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy unless a longer retention period is required, or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims, or for legitimate business purposes, or as provided by law.
